I am forwarding the corrective action taken by the vessel to insure the vessel complies with the requirements. The numbers are from your inspection report (typed) and submitted to the vessel SCOTIA PRINCE.

1. The vessel will implement a log and record the halogen of the shoreside water.
2. Water bunkering is less than one hour in Portland, should this process exceed the required time Free residual halogen test will be performed.
3. when addressing the Portland Water District regarding this test they handed us the pamphlet that the inspector saw when performing his exam. At present I am following up in regards to obtaining the correct report.
4. Hoses are flushed before usage on a daily bases. Hoses are capped and stored in an upright position in the potable water area. When the vessels prepares to relocate operations the vessel will procure its own hoses, couplings and connects, along with the storage cabinet, and "horses".
5. A second chlorination pump has been installed.
6. Parts that were required to have the recorder working have arrived and are installed.
7. A laboratory has been found to do the testing and analyzing of the samples. these tests will be preformed once a month
8. The ship will establish a list of all backflow preventers and vacuum breakers during week 21
9. The ship will establish a list for this procedure
10. Crew administration will establish and monitor the crew checklist for gastrointestinal illness before arriving on vessel. Time frame 72 hours before boarding the vessel
11. keep training
12. Areas gaps seam, will be sealed where possible
- 13 Areas, gaps and seams to be filled where possible
- 14..New piping to be installed to exhaust system. work to be done week 22
15. Gaskets to be repaired when new gaskets are received. Orders are marked ASAP.
16. Gaskets to be repaired and/or replaced
17. Pressure gauge will be either repaired or replaced week 21
18. We are dealing with the supplier for a new lid

19.Drain to be changed to stainless week 22

20.Towel holders and signs to be placed.

21. Will be filled as possible

22. A policy will be developed for this situation.

23.The chief Engineer will develop a plan for inspection

24.A policy to ensure that this procedure is being developed.

25. The vessel is developing a policy for this provision.

26.The company is developing policy for this requirement.

27. repairs to this opening are being performed.

28. The cords will be placed in conduits during week 21

29. We will continue to repair/replace these and other pieces of nonfood equipment.

30. We will continue to repair/replace as required.
