Marice Ashe, JD, MPH is the Director of the Public Health Law Program (PHLP) at the nonprofit Public Health Institute. The following projects comprise PHLP:

- *Technical Assistance Legal Center (TALC)* provides legal information and technical assistance regarding California tobacco control policies.
- *Land Use and Food Stamp Nutrition Education Project* works with nutrition advocates to increase access to healthy foods and physical activity through improvements to the built environment in low-income communities.
- *Legal Tools and School Contracting Project* works with school nutrition advocates to improve or eliminate contracts with food and beverage companies.
- *TB Control and the Law Project* provides legal research and training programs about the protection of community health and individual liberties related communicable diseases.
- *Medicine for People in Need (Medpin)* program improves pharmaceutical access and management at safety net clinics throughout California.
- *Public Health Trust (PHT)* which manages *cy pres* settlements from litigation regarding public health.

Marice teaches Public Health Law at the School of Public Health, University of California at Berkeley. She is a graduate of the University of Notre Dame, and received her MPH and JD from the University of California at Berkeley.
