Tom Farley, MD, MPH is Professor and Chair of the Department of Community Health Sciences at the Tulane University School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine. He is trained as a pediatrician and an epidemiologist and has worked for both the CDC and the Louisiana Office of Public Health. He is the Director of a CDC-funded Prevention Research Center to study the impact of the physical and social environment on obesity. He is coauthor of Prescription for a Healthy Nation (Beacon Press May 2005) in which they argue for building health-promoting environments as the best way to prevent the leading causes of death in the 21st century. Since Hurricane Katrina struck he has been working to rebuild New Orleans in ways that promote health.
