Michal Alberstein, SJD Harvard University; LLB, BA, Tel-Aviv University; is currently a visiting associate professor of law at Fordham University School of law and an adjunct professor at Cardozo school of law. She is a lecturer in jurisprudence and conflict resolution in the faculty of law at Bar-Ilan University. Her current research deals with theories of law and conflict resolution and their intellectual roots; multiculturalism and its relation to negotiation and mediation; and representations of conflict resolution in literature and film. Her book, *Pragmatism and Law: From Philosophy to Disputes Resolution* (UK 2002), deals with the intellectual roots of Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR). Her book in Hebrew *A Jurisprudence of Mediation, and Law* is forthcoming by Haifa University. In 2001, Dr. Alberstein was awarded the prestigious three-year Yigal Alon Scholarship, considered the most competitive scholarship for young outstanding Israeli academics.
