Captain Jesse Bowman is a twenty-seven year veteran with the Fairfax County, Virginia Police Department. He has served as a patrol officer, detective, patrol supervisor, helicopter pilot and Internal Affairs Commander. Currently, he commands the Traffic Division, which includes Motor Carrier Safety Inspectors, Crash Reconstruction Detectives, Motorcycle Officers, Parking Enforcement Officers, Traffic Safety Services Section, Auxiliary Police and the office of the DWI Coordinator.

The Traffic Division is tasked with developing, implementing and spearheading the strategic traffic enforcement, management and public awareness efforts of the entire police department. In addition, the traffic division is responsible for coordinating the highway incident management plan for events which close or restrict traffic on the major highways of Fairfax County.

Captain Bowman is a member of the International Association of Chiefs of Police, Highway Safety Committee, and is chairman of the Enforcement Technologies Advisory Technical Subcommittee. He has lectured and given presentations on traffic safety at the National Lifesavers Safety Conference, MADD national conference, the Defense Threat Reduction Agency, the White House Communications Agency, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments, the Virginia General Assembly and various public and private organizations. He served as the 2005 Chairman of the Law Enforcement Committee for the Regional Smooth Operator Program.
