Mr. Casciotti is Associate Deputy General Counsel (Health Affairs) Department of Defense. He has held that position since 1988. In this capacity he is the principal attorney for the DoD health care system. His prior positions in the Department of Defense were as Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Health Program Management) 1987-1988 and Counselor to the Assistant Secretary of Defense (Health Affairs) 1985-1987.
