Wendy Wagner is the Joe A. Worsham Centennial Professor at the University of Texas School of Law in Austin, Texas. Before joining the Texas faculty, Wagner was a professor at Case Western Reserve University School of Law and a visiting professor at Columbia Law School and the Vanderbilt School of Law. Wagner's research focuses on the law-science interface in environmental law and her articles have appeared in numerous journals, including the Columbia, Cornell, Duke, Illinois, Texas, Wisconsin, and Yale Law Reviews. Wagner serves on the National Research Council's Committee on the Selection and Use of Models in the Regulatory Decision Process, on the Council of the Administrative and Regulatory Law Section, American Bar Association, and is a Member Scholar of the Center for Progressive Regulation.
