Animal sought for euthanasia and testing: Prairie Dog

Under the authority given to the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services in RSMo. Sections 192.020, 192.110 and 19 CSR 20-20.020, 19 CSR 20-20.040 and 19 CSR 20-20.050 the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services hereby orders the removal of the Prairie dog for the purpose of euthanasia and testing to prevent and control zoonotic disease. The animal shall be surrendered for the purpose of euthanasia to a local public health official with subsequent testing of relevant specimens at the Missouri State Public Health Laboratory and federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The owner of said animal shall pay costs associated with this action.

Animals sought for quarantine: Raccoon, dog and puppies (breed unknown), cat and other non-human mammals on the property

Under the authority given to the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services in RSMo. Sections 192.020, 192.110 and 19 CSR 20-20.020, 19 CSR 20-20.040 and 19 CSR 20-20.050 the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services hereby orders the quarantine of the raccoon, dog and puppies (breed unknown), cat, and all other non-human mammals on the property for the purpose of isolation and observation to prevent and control zoonotic disease. The animals shall be quarantined on the property isolated from other animals and humans, the period of which shall end on July 18, 2003 or as soon thereafter as possible. The owner of the animals ordered to be quarantined shall provide written verification by a veterinarian that the animals quarantined are not exhibiting signs and symptoms of Monkeypox. Such verification of the quarantined animals' health shall be provided at the beginning of the quarantine period (not later than June 18, 2003), again at the middle of the quarantine period (between July 1 and July 5, 2003), and at the end of the quarantine period (July 18, 2003). Such costs of verification of the animals' health shall be paid by the owner of said animals. If said owner is unable or unwilling to provide the ordered quarantine on the property to isolate the animals from other animals and humans, the animals shall be surrendered to the local public health authority. The owner of such animals surrendered to the local public health authority shall bear the cost of the quarantine of the animals and evaluation by a veterinarian.
